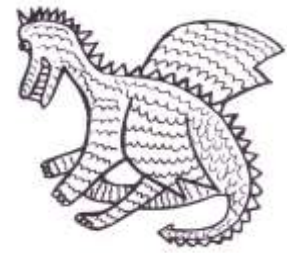

He sometimes makes simple mistakes in planning investigations, as he does not think things through. He just needs to slow down when planning and evaluating an investigation to try and take in all of the possibilities. Encourage Andrew to look at websites & ask 'why' questions about their design.

However, he soon matured and realised the importance of this year; he is now leaving this school with sense of young adulthood about him. He has made great developments this year in his approach to his work and the way that he interacts with his peers.
